## **EEI INFORMATION GUIDELINES**

- **A. Incident / Location / Time** Description of what the incident is, where it is happening, and when it occurred.
- B. **Emergency Medical Facility Sta**tus Facility name, location, and status. Report as operational, damaged, destroyed or limitations.
- C. Local Transportation Status Specific location and condition of major roads, bridges, railroads, waterways, parts, and airports. Report status as restricted, impassible, damaged, destroyed or inaccessible, as appropriate. For highway information, emphasis should be placed on Interstate Highways and other roads designated as Strategic Defense Highways.
- D. **General Damage Characteristics** Information on physical damage to major structures such as government buildings, schools, residential housing, commercial property, and public facilities.
- E. **Area Utility Status** condition of public utilities such as gas, water, electricity, water purification, and sanitation systems. Report as unaffected, limited or unavailable.
- F. **Local Communications Status** Status of local telephone, cell phone, radio, TV, Etc. Report as unaffected, limited or unavailable.
- G. **Information Source / Time** The source and date/time of information for this report. For example, personal observation, , radio station W——, disaster official (name, position and agency), etc.
- H. **Remarks** Appropriate remarks relevant to the report. For example, if telephone service was reported as unavailable in Line F, it could be noted in this paragraph that "the telephone company expects to restore service by \_\_\_\_\_ " if this information is known.
